Skim the <u>Home</u> overview, the 3 links found in the <u>Regulations</u> section, and the <u>Glossary</u>. If you have time, you can skim through some of the additional resources found under the <u>Links</u> section. We will visit the Tutorials, Handouts, Evaluation tools and checklist areas (later in the course)

As you read through the first regulation link – COMAR (Code of Maryland Regulations) – use the search by *Table of Content Structure* and navigate to §section 13A.05.02.13H that specifically applies to instructional and assistive technology, **try to note what areas you think apply to educators and/or local school systems** (LSS).

The other 2 links found in the Regulations section (Maryland Regulations & Section 508, Sub part B, Technical Standards) are both PowerPoint presentations (they are html so shouldn't be a problem viewing) and were done as earlier face to face sessions. We will address some of the questions that arise — for now just focus on the content. In the Maryland Regulations PP, pay special attention to slides 10-20.
