Possible resources and techniques

- 1. Use of graphic organizers to activate background knowledge and to help organize writing.
- 2. Use of Jigsaw activity for collaborative group work.
- 3. Use of dialogue journals
- 4. Allowing Anna to express herself in creative ways
- 5. Class handouts will be distributed to support the content of instructor presentations and lectures.

Possible strategies to use in class

- 1. Encourage Anna to participate in-group discussions by making her responsible for others' learning.
- 2. Seat Anna with another student so that she feels comfortable talking to in a group
- 3. Provide Anna with the resources (such as dictionaries, thesauruses, online dictionaries) she needs to complete classwork
- 4. Anna will be given the opportunity to follow along with the science text materials while the text is read aloud in class, highlight key words, listen to their definitions, and reread sections for comprehension as necessary.

Ideas for support teacher / assistant

- 1. Praise efforts/achievement
- 2. Use dialogue journal to gain insight into Anna's understanding and learning process
- 3. Participate in individual discussion with Anna
- 4. Use multi-sensory methods for teaching

Praise Anna for her achievements

Encourage Anna to complete and turn in her coursework

Provide Anna assistance with her coursework, in her native language, if necessary.

Encourage Anna to speak in whole sentences, articulating the correct pronunciation, sentence structure, and her own ideas in English.
