Digital Forensics Lab coming to life

The [NSF](#) has awarded the [University of Maryland's Office of Information Technology \(OIT\)](#) a \$109,514 grant to establish a regional Digital Forensics Lab (DFL).

The lab, which will be used to teach digital forensics starting next spring, will serve universities and other organizations belonging to the [CyberWATCH consortium](#) in the Washington, D.C. area.

Virtual machines based at the University of Maryland at College Park will provide the technical foundation for the lab.
